



Mailboxes installed on Township roadsides are permitted as a courtesy and are the responsibility of the property owner. Posts for mail boxes should be forty two inches above the ground. The front of the mailbox should be eight inches of the edge of the curb of the road or shoulder. Posts should be 4x4 inch wood posts or a two inch thin wall steel pipe. Not acceptable are posts larger than 4x4 such as railroad ties, mailboxes in brick or cemented piers, I-beams etc. If you have any questions please do not hesitate to contact the Road Superintendent John Spence at 283-5086.
