

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MONTAGUE
BY-LAW NO. 3633-2018

BEING a Bylaw to amend Bylaw 3485-2015 being a Bylaw to authorize the adoption of the delegation of powers and duties policy for the Corporation of the Township of Montague;

WHEREAS Section 270(1) of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, required municipalities to adopt certain policies including the delegation of its power and duties;

AND WHEREAS Section 378 (1) states that (1) A municipality may, after the registration of the tax arrears certificate and before the expiry of the one-year period mentioned in subsection 379 (1), enter into an extension agreement, extending the period of time in which the cancellation price is to be paid, with any of the following persons:

1. Any owner of the land.
2. The spouse of any owner.
3. Any mortgagee.
4. Any tenant in occupation of the land.
5. Any person the treasurer is satisfied has an interest in the land. 2017, c. 10, Sched. 1, s. 61 (1).

AND WHEREAS Section 23.1 (1) of the Municipal Act states that without limiting sections 9, 10 and 11, those sections authorize a municipality to delegate its powers and duties under this or any other Act to a person or body subject to the restrictions set out in this Part.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Montague enacts as follows:

1. That Schedule A of Bylaw 3485-2015, and Schedule A of the Delegation of Powers and Duties Policy be amended to insert the following Delegation of Powers:

2. Should any part, section, subsection or portion of this by-law be repealed or declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be illegal, the same shall not affect the validity of the by-law as a whole or in part thereof, except for that which was declared to be invalid.
3. Where any by-law, passed prior to this by-law, conflicts with the terms of this by-law, this by-law shall prevail.
4. That this by-law comes into force on the day it is passed.
