On March 31, 2020, just after 5:00 p.m., officers from the Carleton Place OPP and Lanark County Paramedics were called regarding a single motor vehicle collision in the ditch on Derry Side Road in Beckwith Township. The investigation resulted in the arrest and charge of the driver, Denise WAHL, age 55 of Arnprior, Ontario, for Failure to Provide Breath Sample. The accused was released from custody on an Appearance Notice with a scheduled court date of June 15, 2020 at the Ontario Court of Justice Perth. The vehicle was impounded for seven days and the accused's driver's licence was suspended automatically for 90 days. There were no injuries as a result of the collision.
